« The 1987 vintage, a rare and delicious wine »

Denomination :

Vin de Pays de l'Hérault.

Harvest dates: (hand-picked)

20 September – 30 September 1987 (11 days).

Grape varieties:

- 62.1% Cabernet Sauvignon.
- 11.5% Merlot.
- 8.6% Syrah.
- 8.6% Malbec.
- 4% Cabernet Franc.
- 2.4% Pinot noir.
- 1.8% Tannat.
- 1% other grape varieties.

Climate:

Frustrating weather all year, unusually heavy rainfall. Flowering between 20 and 30 June. Maturing slow and difficult

Harvest: picking took place in hot, humid mist until early afternoon.

Average age of the vines:

15 years.

Yield:

35 to 45 hl/ha.

Total production:

62.000 bottles, 1.200 magnums, 100 jéroboams and 20 mathusalems.
